 - Aluminum: Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, ideal for rooftop installations where structural load is critical .
 - Zinc-Aluminum-Magnesium (ZAM) alloy: Provides superior corrosion resistance, self-healing properties, high strength, and long-term durability (2-5 times longer than traditional galvanized trays), making it suitable for harsh outdoor environments and a 25+ year PV system lifespan .
- #### 3. Environmental and Load Considerations
- PV cable trays must withstand UV radiation, rain, temperature fluctuations, wind, sand, and salt spray depending on the site location
