

How to arrange the ground wire in the distribution box

The ground wire in a distribution box should be connected to the PE (protective earth) bar, with all metal components properly bonded, using a yellow-green insulated copper wire of appropriate gauge.

Steps to Arrange the Ground Wire

1. Locate the Grounding Bar (PE Bar) Open the distribution box and identify the grounding bar, often marked with "PE" or a grounding symbol. This bar serves as the central point for all grounding connections in the box . 2. Connect the Main Power Ground Wire Use a copper core wire with yellow-green insulation, ensuring the cross-sectional area meets local code requirements. Strip the wire end, insert it into the PE bar terminal, and tighten the screw securely to ensure a firm connection . 3. Ground Internal Electrical Components Any metal parts or electrical components inside the box that require grounding should be connected to the PE bar using individual copper wires. This ensures all components share a common ground and reduces the risk of electrical shock or equipment damage . 4. Ensure Continuity and Low Resistance The grounding system should maintain continuity, with total resistance ideally below 0.1-25 ohms depending on local standards. For metal boxes, the grounding terminal of receptacles can be bonded directly to the box using a grounding clip or screw to maintain a reliable path for fault currents . 5. Additional Precautions

- Clearly label all grounding connections for inspection and maintenance.
- Avoid loose connections, as they can cause sparking or overheating....
