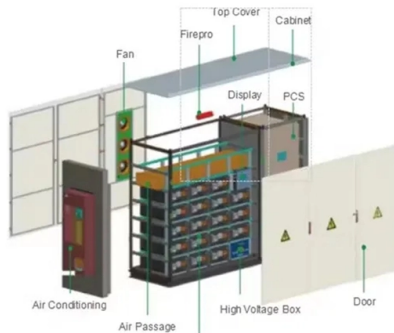


How to cascade switches via optical ports



Article Overview

Cascading optical ports on switches involves connecting multiple switches via fiber optic links, ensuring compatible SFP modules, and following recommended topologies like star, bus, or tree.

Basic Concept of Cascading

Cascading switches means connecting one switch to another to expand the network. This can be done using fiber optic ports (SFP or SFP+ modules) to achieve high-speed, long-distance connections. Theoretically, switches can be cascaded infinitely, but in practice, it is recommended to limit cascades to no more than four layers to maintain performance and manageability .

Steps to Cascade Optical Ports

- Check Compatibility
- Ensure both switches use compatible SFP modules: single-mode or multi-mode, single-fiber or dual-fiber.
- Verify that the wavelengths of the transceivers match, especially for single-fiber BiDi modules.
- Confirm that transmit power and receiver sensitivity are within compatible ranges.
- Ensure port speed and duplex mode are the same on both switches .
- Select the Topology
- Star topology: All switches connect to a central core switch, ideal for high performance and minimal collisions.
- Bus or tree topology: Switches are connected in series or hierarchical layers, suitable...
