

How to connect coated patch cords and fiber optic cables

To connect fiber optic patch cords with coated patch cords, ensure proper cleaning, alignment, and compatible connectors to maintain low signal loss and network reliability.

Step 1: Verify Compatibility

Before connecting, confirm that the fiber types (single-mode OS1/OS2 or multimode OM1-OM5) match between the patch cord and the coated fiber. Also, ensure the connector types (LC, SC, MPO/MTP) are compatible, as mismatched connectors can cause signal loss or damage the fiber endface .

Step 2: Prepare the Coated Fiber

If the coated patch cord is field-terminated:

- Use a fiber optic stripper to carefully remove the outer jacket and buffer coating without nicking the fiber .
- Use a precision cleaver to make a clean, perpendicular cut on the fiber endface, which is critical for minimizing insertion loss .
- If required, polish the fiber endface using a fiber optic polisher for UPC or APC connectors to ensure smooth contact .
