

How to connect fiber optic cables to a FTTH48 core optical distribution box



Overview

First, connect each pre-terminated fiber optic cable to the adapter panel separately, making sure the ports correspond one-to-one; then fix the fiber optic adapter panel to the front panel of the distribution box with the bend radius control clip. We will also discuss how to install fiber termination boxes and maintain them.
