

How to connect the busbar in the distribution cabinet

Connecting a busbar to a distribution cabinet requires selecting the right busbar, securing it with proper connectors or bolts, and following torque and safety standards to ensure reliable power distribution.

Selecting the Busbar

Choose a busbar based on the current and voltage requirements of your system. Copper busbars are preferred for high-current applications due to their excellent conductivity and durability, while aluminum busbars are lighter and more cost-effective but require larger dimensions to match conductivity. Ensure the busbar material and size are compatible with the distribution cabinet and the connected devices.

Preparing the Cabinet

- Verify the layout of the distribution cabinet, including positions for MCCBs, MCBs, or fuse switches.
- Ensure the cabinet is de-energized and properly grounded.
- Check environmental conditions such as temperature, humidity, and potential exposure to corrosive substances to select suitable busbar insulation or protective covers.
