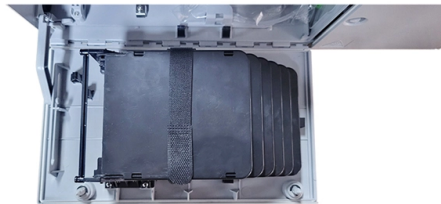


How to connect the small busbar of the central power switch cabinet
