The most common and simplest solution for an ungrounded circuit is to install a Ground-Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) device. Electrical grounding is a fundamental safety mechanism that provides a low-resistance route for fault current to return to the source and trip a circuit breaker or fuse.
