

How to indicate the horizontal level of a cable tray



Article Overview

The horizontal level of a cable tray is indicated by aligning the tray along a level reference line and securing it at specified intervals using supports, hangers, or brackets according to installation standards.

Methods to Indicate Horizontal Level

- **Use of a Level Reference Line** Before installation, mark a horizontal reference line along the intended path of the cable tray. This can be done using a laser level, spirit level, or chalk line to ensure the tray is installed perfectly horizontal across its entire run .
- **Support and Hanger Placement** Cable trays must be supported at regular intervals to maintain the horizontal level. For straight horizontal runs, supports are typically spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart, depending on tray type and load . Hanging rods should have a minimum diameter of 8 mm, and fixed supports should be installed at beam locations, corners, T-junctions, and at the start and end of the tray .
- **Securing the Tray** Once aligned with the reference line, the tray is secured to the supports or hangers. For horizontal runs, cables should be fastened at the start, end, turns, and every 3 to 5 meters along the tray to prevent sagging and maintain level .
- **Use of Adjustable Supports** Adjustable brackets or threaded rods allow fine-tuning of the tray height to match the reference line. This is particularly useful in long runs or when the building structure is uneven .
- **Verification During Installation** Continuously check the horizontal alignment using a level or laser as the tray is installed. Any deviations should be corrected immediately to prevent stress on cables and ensure proper airflow and load distribution
