

How to insert a pigtail cable



Article Overview

To properly insert a pigtail cable, strip the wires, twist them together with a wire nut, and securely attach the pigtail to the device terminal while ensuring the circuit is de-energized.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. **Safety First** Before starting, turn off the power at the breaker and verify that the circuit is de-energized using a non-contact voltage tester. Wear safety glasses and insulated gloves to protect yourself from accidental contact with live wires .
2. **Select the Correct Pigtail Wire** Use a pigtail wire that matches the gauge and material of the existing circuit wires. For standard residential circuits, this is typically 14-gauge for 15-amp circuits and 12-gauge for 20-amp circuits .
3. **Prepare the Wires** Cut the pigtail wire to about 6-8 inches. Strip $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ inch of insulation from the ends of the pigtail and the circuit wires. Ensure the stripped lengths are consistent for a secure connection .
4. **Twist the Wires Together** Align the stripped ends of the circuit wires and the pigtail. Using linesman pliers, twist the wires together clockwise. Then, screw on a wire nut in the same clockwise direction until it fully covers the exposed copper and feels tight. Give each wire a gentle tug to confirm the connection is secure .
5. **Attach the Pigtail to the Device** Loop the free end of the pigtail wire clockwise around the device's screw terminal and tighten the screw securely. For hot and neutral wires, match the wire color to the terminal (black/red for hot, white for neutral). For grounding, connect the green or bare copper pigtail to the device and the metal box if applicable .
6. **Tuck Wires into the Box** Carefully fold and tuck the wires back into the electrical box to avoid pinching or damaging them. Ensure the box is not overcrowded to prevent heat buildup .
