

How to install a residual current device RCD in a distribution box



Article Overview

Installing an RCD in a distribution box involves selecting the correct type, safely connecting the phase and neutral wires, and ensuring proper integration with circuit breakers and busbars.

Step 1: Safety First

Before starting, disconnect the main power supply to the distribution board to prevent electric shock. Use insulated tools and wear protective equipment. Verify that the power is off using a voltage tester.

Step 2: Select the Appropriate RCD

Choose an RCD based on:

- Type (Type AC, A, F, or B) depending on the waveform and load characteristics of your system .
- Rated residual current (commonly 30 mA for personal protection).
- Rated current to match the load of the circuits it will protect .

Step 3: Identify the Distribution Board Layout
