

How to lay the wiring when connecting to a distribution box

Step-by-Step Wiring Arrangement

1. Safety First Before starting, ensure the main power supply is completely turned off. Use an electrical tester to confirm no voltage is present. Wear personal protective equipment such as insulating gloves, safety glasses, and slip-resistant shoes to prevent electric shock or injury . 2. Mount the Distribution Box Fix the box securely to a wall at an accessible height (typically around 1.5 meters). Ensure it is level and stable. For outdoor installations, use a waterproof box and add a rain cover to prevent water ingress . 3. Prepare Wires Strip the insulation of each wire to the required length, ensuring the exposed conductor is neither too long nor too short. This prevents short circuits and ensures proper contact with terminals . 4. Connect Terminals

- Phase wires (live): Connect to the main terminal or the input side of the circuit breakers.
- Neutral wires: Connect to the neutral bus bar.
- Ground wires: Connect to the grounding bar. Ensure each connection is tight and secure, using screws or crimping tools as appropriate . 5. Install Circuit Breakers Position the circuit breakers in their designated slots. Connect each outgoing circuit...
