

How to place a household electrical distribution box

A household electrical distribution box should be installed in a dry, accessible, and ventilated area such as a basement, garage, or utility room, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor, with sufficient clearance for safe operation and maintenance.

Recommended Locations

Household distribution boxes, also known as breaker boxes or electrical panels, are commonly installed in:

- Basements or utility rooms for easy access and protection from weather .
- Garages or unfinished areas where space allows proper clearance and ventilation .
- In some homes, they may be mounted outside near the electrical meter, provided they are weatherproof and comply with local codes .

Height and Accessibility

- The center of the highest circuit breaker should not exceed 6 feet 7 inches (2 meters), and the box should be installed approximately 1.5 meters above the floor for residential setups .
- Ensure clearance around the panel: at least 30 inches wide and 3 feet of front workspace to allow safe operation and maintenance .
- The panel door must be able to open to a 90-degree angle without obstruction
