Fiber optic patch cord markings provide essential information about fiber type, core count, jacket material, length, and connector specifications, helping ensure proper installation and performance.

Printed Text on the Cable Jacket

The text printed along a fiber optic patch cord typically includes several key pieces of information:

- **Manufacturer and Brand:** Identifies the company that produced the cable .
- **Date of Manufacture:** Indicates when the cable was produced, useful for warranty and lifecycle tracking .
- **Fiber Count and Type:** For example, "12F SM G.652.D" means 12 single-mode fibers compliant with the ITU-T G.652.D standard . Multimode fibers may be labeled OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, or OM5 .
- **Core or Buffer Diameter:** Often printed in micrometers, e.g., 250 μm , which is important for splicing and connector selection .
- **Cable Diameter and Weight:** May be listed in inches or millimeters and pounds per 1000 feet or kg/km .
- **Minimum Bend Radius:** Indicates the smallest radius the cable can be bent without damage .
- **Maximum Pulling Tension:** Shows the safe pulling force during installation .
- **Length Markings:** Sequential markings in meters or feet help track cable usage an...
