To safely resolve a tripped circuit breaker, first identify the breaker, ensure proper PPE, reset it fully to “off” before switching “on,” and then diagnose the underlying cause, which may include overloads, short circuits, ground faults, or site vibrations.

Safety First

Before approaching the distribution box, wear appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), including voltage-rated gloves, safety glasses, and insulated footwear. Ensure your hands are dry and you are standing on a dry surface, as even with the main breaker off, incoming service lugs remain energized and pose a shock risk .

Resetting the Breaker

- Open the panel and locate the tripped breaker, which is usually positioned differently from the others .
- Force the handle fully to the “off” position to re-engage the internal latch.
- After a brief pause, switch it firmly to the “on” position. A click should indicate the breaker is closed and power is restored .
- If the breaker immediately trips again, do not repeatedly attempt to reset it; this indicates a persistent fault
