

How to route cables out of the distribution box



Overview

Pull the existing receptacle out of its box and route the cable through a knockout hole in it directly into the new box hole. You can extend a circuit to accommodate the addition of a ceiling light and switch. These routes allow for organised routing over longer distances and offer flexibility for adjustments. Following is how to do this with or without easy access: Nonmetallic cable is routed between wall studs; switches and receptacles fasten to electrical boxes. In dual-RCD boards, put at least one lighting circuit on each RCD so that if one trips, the building is not left in.
