

How to secure the wiring terminals in a distribution box



Article Overview

Secure wiring terminals by properly preparing wires, using the correct terminal type, tightening connections to manufacturer specifications, and verifying each connection for safety and reliability.

Safety First

Always turn off the power before working inside a distribution box and wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including insulated gloves and safety goggles. Ensure the workspace is dry and free of clutter to reduce the risk of electric shock or accidental short circuits .

Preparing the Wires

- Strip the insulation to the manufacturer-recommended length without nicking the conductor.
- For stranded wires, use ferrules to prevent strand separation and improve contact reliability .
- Twist the strands neatly if ferrules are not used, forming a small “crown” shape for better insertion into screw terminals .
