The busbar sizing by current and temperature rise methodology follows seven sequential steps that incorporate design current, material resistivity, target current density, thermal verification, and short-circuit withstand. For most LV motor-control and distribution panels, copper busbars are preferred due to compactness and reliability. Current-carrying capacity (ampacity) The busbar cross-section is selected so that temperature rise under full load stays within limits (typically ≤ 65 K rise over ambient).
