

How to swipe a card in an electrical box or distribution box

To swipe a card in an electrical or distribution box, you need a properly installed access control card reader connected to a power supply and control panel, with careful attention to wiring and mounting on metal surfaces.

Choosing and Mounting the Card Reader

When installing a card reader on a metal electrical box, select a reader compatible with your access control system, such as a magnetic stripe, proximity, or smart card reader . Metal surfaces can interfere with signals, so use a metal mounting plate or faceplate and ensure proper grounding. Position the reader at an accessible height, typically around 48 inches from the ground, and avoid areas prone to physical damage . Drill holes for screws and wiring, using grommets to protect cables from sharp edges.

Wiring the Card Reader

A card reader requires connections to a power supply and a control panel. Typically:

- Power: Connect the red wire (PWR) to +12V and the black wire (GND) to ground on the controller .
- Data lines: For Wiegand readers, connect Data0 (green) and Data1 (white) to the corresponding controller terminals. For RS-485 readers, connect RS485+ (yellow) and RS485- (blue) lines
