Immediately turn off the circuit breaker, isolate the affected circuit, and call a licensed electrician to safely diagnose and repair the short circuit.

Immediate Safety Steps

- Turn off the main power: Switch off the circuit breaker connected to the affected area to prevent electric shock or fire hazards .
- Verify power is off: Use a multimeter or non-contact voltage tester to ensure the circuit is de-energized before touching any wiring .

- Use a multimeter: Measure resistance between hot and neutral wires; a near-zero reading indicates a short circuit .
