

How wide is the circuit 1 of the distribution box

The width of a single circuit slot in a standard distribution box is typically about 0.75 inches (19 mm) per single-pole breaker.

Standard Circuit Slot Dimensions

In most residential and commercial distribution boxes, each circuit is protected by a circuit breaker, and the width of the breaker determines the space allocated for that circuit:

- Single-pole breakers (commonly used for 120V circuits) occupy approximately 0.75 inches (19 mm) of panel width.
- Double-pole breakers (commonly used for 240V circuits) occupy about 1.5 inches (38 mm) of panel width.
- Multi-gang panels are designed to accommodate multiple breakers side by side, with the total panel width increasing proportionally to the number of circuits .

Distribution Box Layout

A typical residential distribution box (load center) has a vertical bus bar arrangement where each breaker snaps into a slot along the bus. The width of the first circuit (circuit 1) is therefore the same as any other single-pole breaker slot, usually 0.75 inches, and the spacing between breakers is standardized to ensure safe installation and compliance with NEC or IEC fill requirements
