NRZ Ethernet switches for Iceland offshore fiber networks can leverage DNV-certified maritime switches and high-speed NRZ transceivers compatible with submarine cables like FARICE-1, DANICE, IRIS, and the upcoming AUÐUR.

Submarine Cable Infrastructure in Iceland

Iceland's international connectivity relies on several submarine fiber optic cables: FARICE-1 (Iceland to Scotland), DANICE (Iceland to Denmark), and IRIS (Iceland to Ireland), with the AUÐUR cable planned to connect southern Iceland to Scotland by 2030 . These cables provide high-capacity Ethernet services, including Ethernet Private Line (EPL) and leased line circuits, with aggregate capacities ranging from 10 Tbps (FARICE-1) to 132 Tbps (IRIS) and projected 320–480 Tbps for AUÐUR . The cables are designed for redundancy, low latency, and high reliability, making them suitable for data center interconnections and cloud services.

NRZ Ethernet Switches for Offshore Use

For offshore or maritime environments, DNV-certified Ethernet switches are recommended due to harsh conditions such as extreme weather, vibration, and saltwater exposure .
