Indoor optical cables are primarily divided into tight-buffered, loose-buffered, and distribution/ribbon types, each designed for specific indoor applications and installation environments.

Main Types of Indoor Optical Cables

1. **Tight-Buffered Cables** These are the most common indoor optical cables, featuring a protective layer applied directly to each fiber. This design provides moisture and physical protection, making them easy to install and terminate without additional splicing or gel removal. Tight-buffered cables are ideal for LANs, data centers, and office environments, and they often come in simplex, duplex, or multi-fiber configurations. They are flexible, support small bending radii, and are compatible with PVC or LSZH jackets for fire safety compliance . 2. **Loose-Buffered Cables** Loose-buffered cables have fibers housed in a larger buffer tube, often filled with a gel-like compound for protection. While more common in outdoor or backbone applications, they are also used indoors when higher fiber counts or additional mechanical protection is required. These cables are suitable for riser or backbone installations where multiple fibers need to be routed over longer distances within a building . 3. **Distribution and Ribbon Cables** Distribution cables are designed for high-density environments, such as data centers, where fibers need to be routed to multiple equipment locations. Ribbon cables, a subtype, arrange multiple fibers in a flat ribbon configuration, allowing efficient mass fusion splicing and space-saving installation. Breakout cables, another variant, bundle multiple fibers in a single jacket but allow...
