Material Selection

- **Galvanized Steel:** Cost-effective for indoor applications with low moisture. Hot-dip galvanized (HDG) is recommended for outdoor or high-humidity environments due to thicker corrosion protection. Suitable for commercial buildings, data centers, and dry industrial areas .
 - **Aluminum:** Lightweight, naturally corrosion-resistant, and non-magnetic. Ideal for coastal regions, outdoor installations, and applications where weight is a concern. Aluminum's natural oxide layer provides protection without additional coatings .
 - **Stainless Steel:** Offers superior corrosion resistance and high-temperature tolerance (up to 800°F). Recommended for chemical plants, food and beverage facilities, pharmaceutical manufacturing, and marine environments. Stainless steel is more expensive but ensures long-term durability and minimal maintenance .
 - **FRP/GRP (Fiber Reinforced Plastic/Glass Reinforced Plastic):** Premium corrosion-resistant option with lifespans of 30-50 years. Non-conductive, lightweight, and maintenance-free, FRP is suitable for chemical processing, wastewater treatment, and highly corrosive environments. Temperature limitations (90-120°F) restrict use in high-heat applications .
- Key Consideration:** The environment is the most critical factor in material selection. Choosing the wrong material can lead to premature failure, safety hazards, and costly replacements
