When selecting trays, consider the load capacity, tray width, and height based on the number and weight of cables to prevent deformation or failure under full load . Ensure the polymer material is fire-retardant or coated with flame-resistant paint if required by local fire safety regulations .

Route Planning and Layout

- Align with building structure: Plan tray routes to follow ceilings, walls, or floors, avoiding unnecessary crossings or detours .
- Shortest and straightest path: Minimizes cable length, reduces voltage drop, and simplifies maintenance .
- Segregation of cables: Separate power and signal cables to reduce electromagnetic interference, using dedicated trays for each type .
- Directional changes: Use horizontal/vertical elbows, T-junctions, and cross-junctio...
