How Fiber Internet Equipment Works

Fiber internet uses an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) instead of a traditional modem. The ONT converts the light signals from the fiber cable into electrical signals that your devices can use. Once the ONT is installed, it connects to a router, which distributes the internet throughout your home via WiFi or Ethernet cables . Unlike DSL or cable, fiber does not require a separate modem .

Router Provision by ISPs

Most fiber providers include a router with your service plan, often optimized for their network speeds and capable of handling gigabit or multi-gigabit connections . These routers are designed to work with fiber's high bandwidth and may support advanced features like WiFi 6 or WiFi 7, multiple Ethernet ports, and mesh networking for larger homes .
