Multimode fiber is generally less expensive than single-mode fiber for short-distance applications, but certain grades and installation factors can make it appear relatively costly.

Why Multimode Fiber Can Be Costly

Multimode fiber (MMF) has a larger core, typically 50 or 62.5 micrometers, allowing multiple light paths, which makes it ideal for short-distance, high-speed networks such as data centers and campus LANs . While the fiber itself is cheaper to manufacture than single-mode fiber due to its larger core, higher-grade multimode fibers like OM4 and OM5 can be more expensive than standard MMF because they are engineered to support higher bandwidths and longer short-range distances . Additionally, specialized connectors and cabling for dense installations can increase costs.

Transceiver Costs

Multimode transceivers are generally much less expensive than single-mode transceivers, ranging from \$20 to \$200 depending on speed, distance, and form factor . They typically use VCSEL (Vertical-Cavity Surface-Emitting Laser) technology, which is cheaper to manufacture than the precise lasers required for single-mode fiber. However, for very high-speed or high-density applications, multimode transceivers may still represent a significant portion of the total cost.
