Unlike copper, fiber optics transmit data using light, enabling higher speeds, greater bandwidth, and more reliable connections. Key telecom companies such as FLOW (formerly Cable & Wireless), Digicel, and FLOW post-merger expansions have been instrumental in deploying fiber networks across urban and rural areas, improving connectivity for homes and businesses .

Coverage and Internet Impact

By 2026, Jamaica is projected to achieve 75% fiber optic coverage, significantly enhancing internet reliability and speeds nationwide . Average broadband speeds are expected to reach 150 Mbps, supporting streaming, remote work, online education, and e-commerce. Internet penetration is forecasted at 85%, with mobile internet usage representing 88% of the population, highlighting a mobile-first digital ecosystem . The expansion of fiber infrastructure is expected to contribute over \$1.2 billion USD to Jamaica's GDP, reflecting its role in economic growth and digital commerce
