Overview

LC (Lucent Connector) fiber optic connectors are small-form-factor connectors with 1.25mm ceramic ferrules, widely used in high-density telecommunications, data centers, and LAN environments . Standard LC connectors are front-facing, but side-opening or side-access LC connectors are engineered to allow the cable to enter or exit from the side, which is particularly useful in high-density patch panels or transceiver modules where front access is limited .

Key Features

- **Compact Design:** LC connectors are half the size of SC connectors, enabling double the port density in racks and panels .
- **Push-Pull Mechanism:** Many side-opening LC connectors use a push-pull tab or boot that allows the connector to be inserted or removed from the side without tools, simplifying installation in tight spaces .
- **Duplex and Simplex Options:** Available in simplex (single fiber) or duplex (paired fibers) configurations, often with a duplex clip to maintain correct polarity .
- **Polarity Flexibility:** Some side-opening LC connectors allow A/B polarity reversal without tools, which is useful for patching operations in dense environments .
- **High-Density Compatibility:** Designed for LC Compact HD panels, these connector...
