Labeling your circuit breakers clearly ensures safety, simplifies troubleshooting, and helps manage your home's electrical system efficiently.

Tools and Materials Needed

- Sticky labels or adhesive-backed paper
- Felt-tipped marker or label maker
- Circuit tester or voltage detector
- Paper and pen for diagramming
- Optional: circuit detector or a second person for the two-person method

Step-by-Step Labeling Process

1. Prepare the Panel Turn off the main breaker to ensure safety. Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses. Verify that circuits are de-energized using a non-contact voltage tester . 2. Number the Breakers Assign a number to each breaker, starting from the top left and moving down, then top right to bottom right. Use 1-inch square sticky labels and write the number next to each breaker . 3. Identify Each Circuit

- Shut down all breakers.
- Turn on the first breaker and check which outlets, lights, or appliances receive power.
- Mark each outlet or fixture temporarily to avoid confusion....
