- **OSHA and NFPA Standards:** Proper labeling is required in commercial and residential settings to meet safety regulations and avoid inspection penalties .
- **Descriptive Labels:** Use specific descriptions rather than vague terms. For example, “Living Room – east wall outlets, ceiling light, hallway light” is preferable to just “Li...
