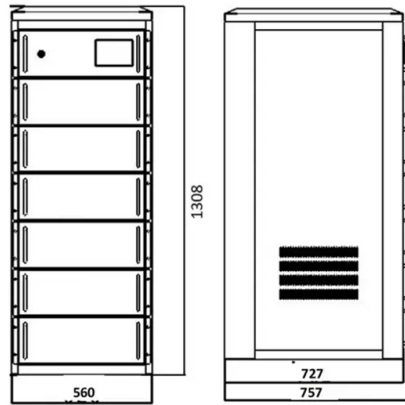

A fiber optic pigtail is a short optical fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, used to splice into a larger fiber optic cable or network system. A large core pigtail differs from standard pigtails by having a larger core diameter, typically ranging from 50 μm to 100 μm or more, compared to standard single-mode (8-10 μm) or multimode (50/62.5 μm) fibers. The larger core allows for easier alignment during splicing and higher tolerance for light coupling, making it ideal for certain industrial, sensor, or high-power applications.
