Yes, cable trays can be installed in a stacked or multi-level configuration, but proper separation and support are essential to ensure safety and minimize interference.

Vertical Stacking and Layered Separation

In industrial and commercial installations, it is common to position electrical (power) cable trays above instrumentation or control cable trays. This layered arrangement helps reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI) from high-current power cables affecting sensitive signal or control lines below. When stacking trays, maintaining a minimum vertical separation is critical; industry standards often recommend at least 300 mm (12 inches) between power and control trays to ensure proper isolation and heat dissipation.

Support and Structural Considerations

Cable trays must be mechanically supported to handle the weight of the cables and the trays themselves. Supports can include wall brackets, ceiling suspensions, or steel structures, and they should be designed to maintain the integrity of both horizontal and vertical tray arrangements. Multi-level trays should avoid excessive load on the lower tray, and all trays must be securely fastened to prevent sagging or movement over time.
