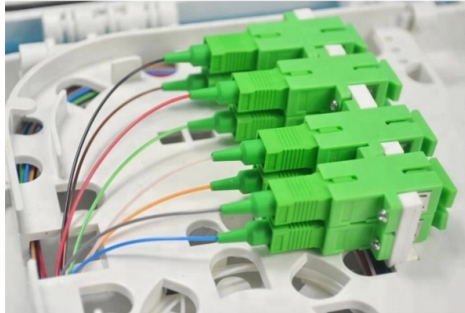


Location of the construction site s third-level electrical distribution box



Article Overview

The third-level distribution box, or switch box, is installed closest to the electrical equipment it serves, forming the final stage of the construction site's three-level power distribution system.

Understanding the Three-Level Distribution System

Construction sites typically use a three-level electrical distribution system:

- **First-Level Distribution Box (Main Distribution Box):** Positioned near the incoming power source, it manages and monitors the overall site power, housing main circuit breakers, leakage protectors, voltmeters, and ammeters .
- **Second-Level Distribution Box (Sub-Distribution Box):** Located near large equipment or power consumption areas, it receives power from the first-level box and distributes it to third-level boxes. It contains branch circuit breakers and leakage protectors .
- **Third-Level Distribution Box (Switch Box):** Installed directly adjacent to the electrical equipment it controls, this box provides the final connection and protection. It typically contains isolation switches, circuit breakers, and leakage protectors, and is designed to control one machine or a group of similar machines .

Practical Placement Guidelines

- The switch box should be within 3 meters of the equipment it serves; beyond this distance, it should not be used for direct distribution .
- It should be installed in a ventilated, dry, and safe location, away from gas, smok...
