Preoperative Planning

Successful manual placement begins with thorough preoperative assessment. This includes evaluating bone quality, anatomical structures, and the intended prosthetic outcome. Implants should be selected according to manufacturer specifications, avoiding mixing components from different systems to prevent mechanical failure or legal liability . Surgeons should be trained and ideally certified in ceramic implant procedures, as handling errors are a common source of complications .

Implant Design Considerations

Ceramic implants often feature tapered bodies, trapezoidal threads, and internal connections to enhance primary stability and bone compaction . For example, the Neodent® Zi system uses a double trapezoidal thread and apically tapered design, while the Straumann® PURE system employs a straight internal connection with rotational lock for abutment stability . Understanding these design features is critical for proper seating and load distribution.

Surgical Technique

- Positioning: Place the implant along the natural tooth axis or intended prosthetic alignment, ensuring preservation of surrounding bone width
