Active Optical Cables combine high-quality optical fibers with protective coatings, strength members, and integrated electronics to ensure high-speed, reliable data transmission.

Core and Cladding Materials

The core of an AOC is typically made from ultra-pure silica (SiO_2), often doped with germanium to control the refractive index, which enables efficient light transmission with minimal signal loss over long distances . The cladding, surrounding the core, is also made of silica but with a slightly lower refractive index to keep light confined within the core. Some AOCs may use plastic optical fibers for short-distance or flexible applications, offering lightweight and bendable alternatives .

Coatings and Protective Layers

To protect the delicate glass fibers, AOCs use dual-layer UV-cured acrylate coatings: a soft primary coating cushions the fiber, while a hard secondary coating provides mechanical protection . Additional protective layers include buffer tubes, water-blocking elements, and armoring (e.g., steel or aramid yarns) to enhance durability, tensile strength, and resistance to environmental factors . Jackets are often made from polyethylene, PVC, or low-smoke zero-halogen (LSZH) materials, providing fire resistance, UV protection, and chemical stability .
