

Methods for rounding corners of cable trays



Article Overview

Corners of cable trays can be rounded using field bending, strategic cuts, or prefabricated fittings while maintaining proper bend radius and NEC compliance.

Field Bending and Cutting

For wire mesh cable trays, installers often perform on-site bending to navigate 90-degree turns or irregular angles. This involves making strategic side cuts in the tray and carefully bending the mesh to form a smooth corner transition. Maintaining the minimum bend radius is crucial to prevent damage to Ethernet, fiber, or power cables and to ensure proper cable performance and longevity (ShowMeCables) . After bending, verify grounding and bonding to maintain electrical safety.

Using Prefabricated Fittings

Many cable tray systems, especially ladder or solid-bottom trays, offer factory-made corner fittings such as elbows or radius bends. These fittings provide a uniform bend radius and reduce the risk of cable stress or overfilling at corners. They are particularly useful in high-density installations or where aesthetics and cable management are important (BEAMA Guide) .
