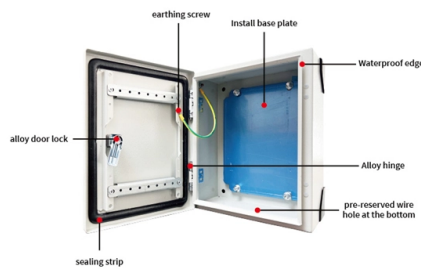


Multiple distribution boxes on one circuit

Using an SDB downstream of an MDB allows a single circuit to feed multiple locations safely, provided the total load does not exceed the circuit rating . **Box Sizing and Fill Limits:** Each distribution box has a maximum capacity, known as box fill, which limits the number of wires, breakers, and devices it can safely accommodate. Overcrowding can lead to overheating and electrical hazards. Proper sizing ensures room for future expansion and compliance with standards like NEC or IEC . **Circuit Protection:** Each segment of the circuit should be protected by appropriately rated breakers or fuses. If multiple boxes are used, the upstream breaker must match the total load, and downstream boxes may include additional protective devices if needed . **Planning and Documentation:** Electrical diagrams are crucial when using multiple boxes for one circuit.
