

Multiple switches using a single fiber optic cable



Article Overview

A single fiber optic cable can connect multiple switches, but the number of switches is limited by the number of fiber strands and the network topology used.

Fiber Strands and Switch Connections

A fiber optic cable contains one or more individual fibers, each capable of carrying a separate data signal. For example, a 6-strand fiber cable can typically connect up to 3 switches back to a core switch, depending on whether single or dual fibers are used per connection . Each fiber strand can be terminated with connectors like LC or SC to interface with switch ports .

Topology Considerations

When connecting multiple switches, the network topology plays a critical role:

- **Star Topology:** Each switch connects directly to a central core switch. This is high-performing and reduces collisions, but requires more fiber strands for each connection .
- **Daisy Chain or Cascade:** Switches are connected in series, where one switch uplinks to the next. While theoretically unlimited, practical recommendations suggest no more than four layers to maintain performance and signal integrity .
- **Hub-and-Spoke or Tree:** Useful for larger networks, where edge switches connect to intermediate switches, which then connect to the core
