Connecting Copper Ethernet Cables

Copper Ethernet cables (Cat5e, Cat6, Cat6a, Cat8) are typically connected using RJ-45 connectors. The main steps include:

- Cutting and stripping the cable: Remove the outer jacket carefully without damaging the inner wires.
- Arranging the wires: Follow the T568A or T568B wiring standard to ensure proper pinout.
- Crimping: Insert the wires into an RJ-45 connector and use a crimping tool to secure the connection.
- Testing: Use a cable tester to verify continuity and correct wiring. Ethernet cables have a maximum recommended length of 100 meters (328 feet) to maintain signal integrity, and outdoor runs should consider surge protection and shielding to prevent electrical interference .
