Overview

Single-gang boxes are the most common type, used for one switch or outlet. Common uses: wall outlets, light switches, low-voltage controls. Tip: Depth is often more critical than width when wire count. A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. The distribution box (DB box) helps safely and efficiently distribute electrical power. Today, electrical systems are essential for homes and industries. The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board. Most of the time, each of these secondary circuits will be protected with a fuse or breaker. Whether you are installing outlets, switches, lighting fixtures, or junction connections, box size directly affects wire fill capacity, device fit, and installation quality.
