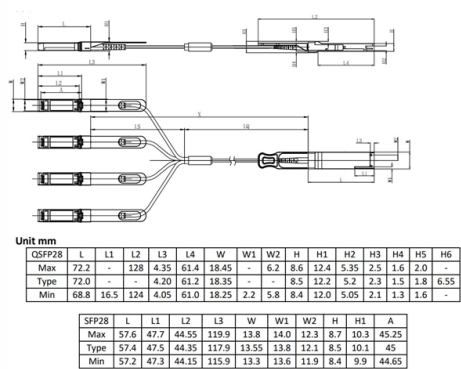

An Optical Distribution Network (ODN) is the passive fiber infrastructure that connects the central office to end users, enabling efficient, reliable, and scalable delivery of optical signals in FTTH and PON networks.

Overview

An ODN is the passive portion of a fiber optic network that links the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) at the service provider's central office to Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at customer premises . Unlike active devices, the ODN requires no external power and consists entirely of passive components that guide, split, and protect optical signals . It forms the backbone of FTTH deployments and is critical for network performance, scalability, and maintenance efficiency .

Key Components

- Optical Fiber Cables: Single-mode fibers (e.g., G.652D or G.657A2) that carry light signals over long distances with minimal attenuation and high bend resistance .
- Optical Splitters: Passive devices that divide one optical signal into multiple outputs, supporting ratios like 1:8, 1:16, 1:32, or 1:64, enabling point-to-multipoint connectivity .
- Distribution Frames and Closures: Enclosures for splicing, terminating, and managing fibers, protecting them from environmental damage and mechanical stress .
- Connectors and Patch Cords: Provide plug-and-play terminations and flexible connections between fibers and network devices .
- Drop Cables: Connect the optical access point to the ONUs/ONTs at subscriber pre...
