An optical module is a device that converts electrical signals to optical signals and vice versa, while an optical port is the physical interface on the module or device where the fiber optic cable connects.

Optical Module

An optical module is an electronic device used in high-bandwidth data communications to bridge electrical equipment and optical fibers. It typically contains a transmitter (TOSA) that converts electrical signals into light, a receiver (ROSA) that converts incoming light back into electrical signals, functional circuitry, and an optical interface for fiber connection. Modules can be pluggable (like SFP or QSFP) or embedded, and they support various transmission speeds and distances. They are essential for enabling data transmission over fiber optic networks.

Optical Port

An optical port is the physical connector on the optical module or networking device where the fiber optic cable is plugged in. It serves as the interface between the module and the external fiber network. Optical ports can be single-fiber (BiDi) for bidirectional communication over one fiber or dual-fiber for separate transmit and receive fibers. The port itself does not perform signal conversion; it simply provides the connection point for the optical signal....
