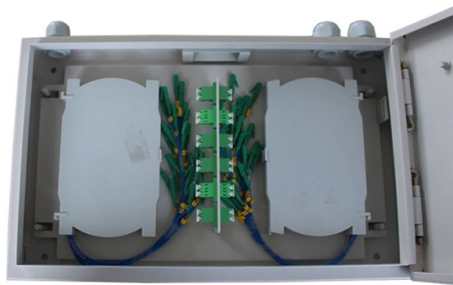


Optical Cable Replacement Process

1. Planning and Preparation

Before replacing fiber optic cables, map the cable route and assess the environment, including existing conduits, trays, or ceiling spaces. Determine whether the replacement is indoor, outdoor, aerial, or direct-buried, as each method requires specific handling and safety considerations. Identify the type of fiber needed—single-mode for long distances or multimode for shorter runs—and ensure compatibility with existing connectors and equipment .

Carefully remove the old optical cable without damaging surrounding infrastructure. Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling, as fiber strands are delicate and can break easily. For underground or aerial cables, follow proper safety protocols and use appropriate tools to access the cable .

Route the new fiber optic cable along the planned path, maintaining the minimum bend radius (typically 10 times the cable diameter) to prevent signal degradation.
