Common Connector Types in Optical Modules

Optical modules, such as SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) and GBIC (Gigabit Interface Converter), use fiber optic connectors to interface with patch cables. While SC and FC connectors were historically common, modern optical modules predominantly use LC connectors due to their smaller size, higher port density, and ease of use in high-density environments like data centers. SC connectors are still used in some GBIC modules and older network equipment, while FC connectors are typically found on patch panels or ODFs where high stability is required.

Connector Characteristics

- LC (Lucent Connector): Small square connector with a 1.25mm ferrule, ideal for SFP modules and high-density installations. It uses a latch mechanism for easy plug-and-play.
- SC (Subscriber Connector): Larger square connector with a plug-in latch, commonly used in GBIC modules and general-purpose networking. It is easy to connect and disconnect but occupies more space.
- FC (Ferrule Connector): Circular metal connector with a threaded design, providing high stability and low insertion loss, often used in long-distance or high-vibration environments.
- MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors used in high-density cabling and backbone netw...
