A router OLT optical module is a pluggable transceiver that enables a standard router to function as an Optical Line Terminal (OLT) in a Passive Optical Network (PON).

Overview

An OLT (Optical Line Terminal) is the central device in a PON, connecting the service provider's core network to multiple subscriber endpoints via optical fibers and splitters (). Traditionally, OLTs are standalone chassis-based devices, but pluggable OLT optical modules allow standard routers to perform OLT functions without requiring a dedicated chassis ().

Functionality

The router OLT optical module performs several key tasks:

- **Signal Conversion:** Converts electrical signals from the router into optical signals for transmission over fiber ().
- **Traffic Management:** Coordinates downstream and upstream data between the router and multiple ONTs/ONUs at subscriber premises ().
- **Bandwidth Allocation:** Dynamically assigns bandwidth to connected users to ensure stable performance ().
- **Control & Maintenance:** Handles authentication, ranging, and security for all connected subscribers ().
