An optical fiber is a thin strand of glass or plastic designed to transmit data as pulses of light. Each fiber has a core, where light travels, surrounded by a cladding with a slightly lower refractive index to keep the light confined through total internal reflection. Fibers are typically coated with protective layers to prevent damage and reduce signal loss, but these coatings do not contribute to the optical transmission itself .

Optical Cable

An optical cable (or fiber-optic cable) is an assembly that contains one or more optical fibers bundled together within a protective sheath. This sheath shields the fibers from environmental factors such as moisture, temperature changes, and physical stress, ensuring reliable data transmission. Additional layers, such as buffers, jackets, and sometimes armor, provide mechanical strength and durability for indoor, outdoor, or undersea applications .
