Understanding Cable Tray Tee Layout

A tee in a cable tray system is a junction where one tray branch splits from the main run. Calculating its length and distance involves:

- Tray width and type: The width of the main and branch trays affects the tee size and spacing between supports .
- Standard tray lengths: Cable trays are typically available in 12, 20, 24, and 30-foot lengths, with some manufacturers offering up to 40 feet . Tee sections are usually cut or fabricated to match these lengths.
- Support spacing: Short-span trays are supported every 6–8 feet, intermediate spans every 10–12 feet, and long spans 14–20 feet. Tee placement must align with these support intervals to maintain structural integrity .

Step-by-Step Tee Calculation

- Determine the tray width: Add the total cable width, spacing between cables, and a future expansion allowance to get the required tray width .
- Select tee length: Tee sections should be long enough to span between supports. For example, if the support span is 10 feet, the tee length should be at least 10 feet...
