Fiber optic cable prices increase with core count, ranging from \$0.13 per foot for 1-core cables to \$6 per foot for high-density 288-core cables, with variations based on fiber type, construction, and environment.

Typical Price Ranges by Core Count

- 1-core FTTH drop cable: Around \$0.13 per foot, suitable for single connections in residential or small-scale deployments .
- 12-core cables: Approximately \$0.50 per foot for standard indoor or outdoor single-mode fiber, commonly used in communication rooms or small distribution networks .
- 24-core cables: Around \$1.00 per foot, often used in main distribution rooms or medium-scale enterprise networks .
- 48-core cables: Prices range from \$0.90 to \$1.20 per meter for ADSS aerial cables, depending on jacket material and tensile strength .
- 96-core and higher (e.g., 144-core, 288-core): Can reach \$6 per foot for high-density backbone cables, typically used in data centers or large-scale network backbones .

Factors Affecting Price

- Fiber Type:
- Single-mode fiber is generally cheaper per foot (\$0.10-\$0.50) than multimode fiber (\$0.30-\$1.00), but requires more expensive equipment .
- Premium brands like Corning® or Fujikura® cost more than generic fibers
