

Pulling the fiber optic cable conduit



Article Overview

Pulling fiber optic cable through conduit requires careful planning, proper conduit preparation, tension management, and adherence to bend radius limits to prevent cable damage.

Conduit Preparation

Before pulling fiber, ensure the conduit is clean, properly sized, and free of obstructions. Measure the inner diameter to confirm the cable fits comfortably without excessive strain, and inspect for debris, sharp edges, or breaks that could damage the cable jacket or fibers during the pull. For long or multi-bend runs, consider installing innerducts to separate individual fiber runs and provide a smooth interior pathway .

Cable Handling and Attachment

Fiber optic cables should never be pulled by the outer jacket. Instead, attach the pull string or pulling grip to the cable's strength members, such as Kevlar (Aramid) yarn, using a Kellems grip or swivel pulling eye to prevent twisting and distribute tension evenly . For pre-terminated cables, use specialized pulling eyes to protect connectors.

Lubrication

Reducing friction is critical, especially for long runs or multiple bends. Apply a fiber-cable-rated, water-based pulling lubricant to both the cable jacket and the conduit i...
